835		OB Dump alongside PWD Road starting from Banjari mandir to Milupara as shown in Annexure-II. Cumulatively, we have 17,429 trees planted within our mining lease. Barbed wire fencing with RCC M15 grade boundary pillars of 7.78 kms starting from View point to PWD road, along and back side of OB Dump at Milupara village, left side of PWD road are completed. Fencing photographs are attached vide Annexure-III.
4.	The following activities shall be undertaken by the User Agency under supervision of the State Forest Department at the project cost:	
(a)	Mitigative measures to minimize soil erosion and choking of stream shall be implemented within a period of three year with effect from the issue of Stage-II clearance in accordance with the approved Plan in consultation with the State Forest Department.	Lemon grass is planted on the OB dump along the slopes to improve soil strength and reduce water infiltration; thereby minimizing soil erosion, reducing choking of garland drains and incidences of landslides as well. A total of 2000 m2 area has been covered in Lemon grass. Drip irrigation has been installed covering a total area of about 2135 m2 on the OB dump to provide water and sustaining the plantation and grassing on the topsoil dump. Photos of grassing and plantation at OB dump are shown in Annexure-IV. Garland drains
		are provided around the mine wherever required to arrest any soil from the mine area being carried away by the rain water.
(b)	Planting of adequate drought hardy plant species and sowing of seeds, in the appropriate area within the mining lease to arrest soil erosion in accordance with the approved scheme;	mentioned in Annexure-V are being carried out and additional plantation activities will be undertaken as per the progress of the mine. Plantation of around 750 trees have been done on the top soil dump and 100 kg seedings on the contractors workshop area to arrest soil erosion are undertaken. Seeds o Acacia catechu (Khair) and Acacia auriculiformis are also sowed in the Milupara OB Dump.
c)	Construction of check dams, retention /to- walls to arrest sliding down of excavated material along the contour in accordance with the approved scheme.	e Garland drains are constructed along the pit boundary and periphery of the external dumps to arrest to stop inrust of external water inside the mines.
