INSTRUCTIONS FOR BIDDERS

- 1.1 Sealed offers are invited by the CHIEF ENGINEER (S/s-O&M), C.G. State Power Transmission Co. Ltd, Daganiya, Raipur – 492 013, for providing Attendant (Helper) staff for EHV S/S under CE (S/S- O&M) CSPTCL, Raipur as per terms of specification attached.
- 1.2 The tenders duly filled in shall be dropped/get dropped in the specified tender box up to 14:00 Hrs. on or before the due date. Any other means of delivery shall not be accepted. No receipt of tender shall be issued in any case. The due date of submission of tender is 25.02.2021 till 14.00 Hrs. and date of opening of tender is 25.02.2021 at 14:30 hrs in the O/O CHIEF ENGINEER(S/s-O&M) CSPTCL, Raipur. Tender box shall be sealed at 14.00 Hrs on 25.02.2021 and in no case tenders shall be allowed to be dropped after 14.00 Hrs.

1.3 PRE-BID QUALIFYING REQUIREMENTS:-

- a) The Bidder should have valid labour license for providing manpower issued by Labour Department, Govt. of CG. Bidder should submit self attested copy of valid labour license. or shall submit an undertaking with the tender offer mentioning that he will submit the labour license within 30 days from the date of issue of LOA. The format of undertaking is enclosed as Annexure-IV.
- b) Bidder must have ES insurance registration/license .Bidder should submit self attested copy of ES insurance registration.
- c) Bidder should have PF code No. issued by the competent authority under the provision of Employee Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act-1952 and submit the self attested copy of PF registration.
- d) The Bidder should have a valid GST registration number.
- e) (I) The bidder should have minimum average annual turnover (MAAT) for best 3 year out of these Financial Years i.e. 2014-15, 2015-16, 2016-17, 2017-18, 2018-19 & 2019-20 of Rs. 44 Lakhs. In case where Audited Balance sheet of FY 2019-20 is not available then :-
 - (i) The bidder shall submit "provisional balance sheet for FY-2019-20 duly countersigned by CA" and
 - (ii) A self declaration of this effect countersigned by a practicing chartered accountant needs to be attached.

In such cases audited balance sheets of Financial Years for FY 2014-15 to 2018-19 shall be considered.

In case bidder is a holding company, MAAT shall be that of holding company only (i.e. excluding its subsidiary/ group companies). In case bidder is a subsidiary of a holding company, the MAAT shall be of subsidiary company only (excluding its holding company).

(II)Net worth of bidder for last three financial years i.e. 2017-18, 2018-19 & 2019-20 out of submitted balance sheets as per clause 1.3 e (I) above should be positive. In case audited balance sheet for FY 2019-20 is not available, networth as per audited balance sheet of previous three years i.e. 2016-17, 2017-18 & 2018-19 should be considered for above criteria and for this, the bidder should submit provisional balance sheet for FY-2019-20 duly countersigned by CA and the self-declaration countersigned by CA as per clause 1.3 e (I) above regarding non-availability of audited balance sheet for FY 2019-20.

Net worth means the sum total of paid-up capital and free reserves (excluding reserves created out of revaluation) reduced by aggregate value of accumulated losses (including debit balance in profit and loss account for current year) and intangible assets.

The Following Documents should be Submitted in Support of qualifying the financial requirement:-

The bidder should submit the self attested copies of following documents:-

- Statement of annual turnover, audited balance sheets and profit & loss statement duly certified by Chartered Accountant. The audited balance sheets furnished should be for these financial years (i.e. FY 2014-15, 2015-16, 2016-17, 2017-18, 2018-19 & 2019-20). In case where audited balance sheet of FY 2019-20 is not available, then:-
 - (i) The bidder shall submit "provisional balance sheet for FY-2019-20 duly countersigned by CA" and
 - (ii) A self-declaration of this effect countersigned by a practicing chartered accountant needs to be attached.
- II. A statement showing 'Net worth' including assets and liability of the bidder duly certified by chartered accountant for the last three financial years (i.e. FY 2017-18, 2018-19 & 2019-20) shall also be furnished. In case audited balance sheet for FY 2019-20 is not available, net-worth as per audited balance sheet of previous three years i.e. 2016-17, 2017-18 & 2018-19 should be considered for above criteria and for this, the bidder should submit provisional balance sheet for FY-2019-20 duly countersigned by CA and the self-declaration countersigned by CA as per clause 1.3 (e) above regarding non-availability of audited balance sheet for FY 2019-20.

The documentary evidence in support of (a), (b), (c), (d) & (e) above shall be submitted along with tender.

Note: - Bidders must enclose the documents in support of pre-bid qualifying conditions without which the tender will summarily be rejected. Therefore bidder must ensure submission of relevant documents in support of pre-bid qualifying requirement along with bid.

However, if any short coming is observed during scrutiny of TC bid, CSPTCL reserves the right to seek required clarification/documents from bidder by giving them only one chance to submit required document/ clarifications/ confirmations within specified time limit.

Other Terms & Conditions of tender are given below:

1.4 **<u>THREE PART BID</u>**:- Sealed Tender are invited in Duplicate on three part basis, One envelope containing the E.M.D. clearly super scribed with the Name of the tender, Second envelope should contain the tender form with required documents (Techno-commercial details and other documents) and Third envelope should contain the price bid. All the three envelopes shall be kept in one large sealed envelope, addressed to the CHIEF ENGINEER (S/S-O&M), C.G. State Power Transmission Co. Ltd Daganiya, Raipur with the name of work, tender specification number, due date of tender, amount & mode of E.M.D. and name of the bidder super scribed on the cover.

1.5 SCOPE OF WORKS:-

To assist the gang leaders, Asstt. Line man/Lineman/Line supervisor and above in discharging, constructional, erection, installation and maintenance activities associated with EHV substations & their equipments under the supervision of company's authorized personnel within the preview of Indian Electricity Act in force.

1.6 **QUALIFICATION :-**

- The Attendant (Helper) should have minimum educational qualification of 10th pass.
- The Attendant (Helper) should have minimum 18 year age and maximum 40 year age.
- The persons to be deployed by contractor shall have no criminal record.

1.7 **DUTIES:**-

The Attendant (Helper) normal working hours is 08 hours, he will be required to work even in late hours also, if situation warrants.

1.8 WORKING TIME:-

Attendant (Helper) will have normal field working 8 hours. He will be required to work in emergency beyond 8 hours of normal working hours, if required and shall be bound to work on holidays/ Sunday etc. if situation warrants. Non compliance in this regards will be treated as and lead to breach of contract.

1.9 VERIFICATION OF DOCUMENTS:-

The verification of certificates and education of Attendant (Helper) shall be done by the contractor himself and the document submitted shall be verified by the officer in charge.

- 1.10 Bidders are required to submit their offer with complete information as desired in various Schedules. They may also enclose separate sheet wherever necessary.
- 1.11 **<u>VALIDITY</u>**: Full descriptive particulars and complete specifications should accompany the offer. Offers should be kept open for acceptance for at least 180 days from the date of opening.
- 1.12 Offers through Telegraph/Fax/E-mail will not be considered.
- 1.13 **EARNEST MONEY**: Each bidder shall submit an earnest money of Rs.1,45,000./-(Rs. One lakh forty five thousand) along with submission of quotation in a separate envelope. The tenders not accompanied with adequate earnest money will summarily be rejected and returned unopened. No interest shall be payable on the earnest money deposited by the bidder.
- 1.14 **FORM OF EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT**: The earnest money deposit can be furnished in form of Bank Draft issued by Nationalized/Scheduled Bank payable to the Manager (RAO-H.Q.), CSPTCL, RAIPUR.
- 1.15 **FORFEITURE OF EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT**: It should be clearly understood that in the event of bidder failing to accept or execute the detailed orders, if order is placed within the validity period of the offer (as per clause 1.11) the full amount of earnest money will be forfeited, and Company's decision in this respect will final and binding on the bidder.
- 1.16 **A.** <u>**GST**</u> :- The Bidder shall submit documentary evidence for Registration regarding GST with appropriated authority. Payment of GST shall be made to the contractor as per prevailing rules.

B. <u>OTHER TAXES / DUTIES</u> :- The taxes will be applicable as per prevailing rates for work completion within specified time. It may be noted that only statutory variations due to Govt. regulations in the rate of GST or other taxes (if any) shall be payable by the CSPTCL only within contractual period. In case, the contract affected late i.e. beyond contractual completion period and rates of GST and other taxes (if any) undergoes upward revision, the payment will continue to be made only on the basis of rates prevailing during the contractual period. However, in case the rate of statutory levies undergoes downward revision, then the delayed work completion beyond contractual period will attract reduced rate of levies.</u>

- 1.17 **INCOME TAX DEDUCTION**: Deduction towards income tax will be made from the contractor's bills as per rules in force.
- 1.18 **<u>PERIOD OF CONTRACT</u>**: The contract period will be for the period of 01 (One) YEARS from date of issue of order.

- 1.19 **EXTENSION CLAUSE**:- The contract will be for One year from date of issue of order. It may be extended for further period of Six month on same rates, terms & condition or the contract period may be curtailed as desired by CSPTCL.Apart from this, the number of helpers may be increased up to the 50% of the employed helpers, if the situation warrants.
- 1.20 <u>AGREEMENT</u>:- The contractor will execute an agreement on non-judicial stamp paper worth Rs. 300/- with revenue stamp of Rs. 01 (one) affixed on it, as per the Annexure-I enclosed with this tender document. The cost of stamp paper etc. shall be borne by the contractor. The agreement is to be executed within 15 days from the date of order for execution of contract award for providing Attendant (Helper) staff for 400 KV & 132 KV S/S for 2021-22.
- 1.21 **SECURITY DEPOSIT**: The contractor shall furnish security deposit either in form of DD drawn in favour of Manager (RAO-H.Q.), CSPTCL, Raipur or FDR pledged with the Manager (RAO-H.Q.), CSPTCL, Raipur or in the form of Bank Guarantee from Nationalized/Scheduled Bank for an amount of 10% of one year's contract value (including GST/Cess etc. if any) for faithful performance of the order and to cover the guarantee period. The SD shall be submitted within 30 days of receipt of LOA and shall be kept valid for period covering the completion date plus 6 months. In the event of extension of completion date, the validity of the bank guarantee shall also be suitably extended. The bank guarantee shall be executed in stamp paper, as per annexure attached with this tender document, worth Rs. 300/- or as per the prevailing legal requirements. The cost of stamp paper shall be borne by the bidder. No interest shall be payable on the Security Deposit.
 - Note: 1) The security deposit shall be released only after satisfactory completion of the work duly certified by the concerned OIC.

2) Without acceptance of security deposit by order placing authority, no payment will be released to the contractor.

- 1.22 **FORFEITURE OF SECURITY DEPOSIT**: The CSPTCL at its option may forfeit the security deposit in case of any of the following;
 - i) Un-satisfactory performance of the contractor during the contract period which is subsequently reported by concerned OIC.
 - ii) Non-compliance of the terms & conditions laid down in the contract due to which the order is considered for cancellation.
 - iii) Repeatedly (more than 3 times) delayed payments to deployed staff.
 - iv) In case, it is reported that deployed persons are being paid less salary or a part of salary is taken back by the contractor after depositing the salary in bank account from the staff and if proved correct the contract shall be terminated and contractor shall be black listed with forfeiture of security deposit along with other stern punitive action.

1.23 **PENALTY :**

If the contractor/bidder fails to perform the work as per specification, the penalty shall be levied as under:-

i. In the event of contractor's staff absconding from the place of duty (i.e. none of the staff are available) or fails to perform the assigned job as defined under "scope of work" or bidder failing to arrange suitable substitute then a penalty of Rs. 500/-shall be deducted against each such event.

If the staff engaged by contractor remains absent from duty, then the CSPTCL has the right to recover the expenditure incurred, from contractor for making alternate arrangement during such event.

- ii. If the contractor fails to execute the contract, from the date of handing over of site within stipulated time frame, the CSPTCL shall recover from the contractor as penalty a sum of half percent (0.5%) of the monthly contract price of the work for each calendar week of delay. The total penalty shall not exceed 10% (ten percent) of the contract price. Alternatively, work may be got done through other agency/contractor, on account and at the risk of the firm to whom the contract is originally awarded OR CSPTCL may cancel the contract for the in-completed work, with liability recoverable from the contractor, as assessed by the CSPTCL.
- iii. If under-qualified persons of the contractor are found on duty, then a penalty of Rs. 10,000/- per person will be deducted from contractor's bill whenever noticed. In case of repetition of same incidence more than two times, the provisions for termination of contract shall apply apart from penalty.
- iv. It is the contractor's responsibility to make payment to the deployed staff on 10th of every month irrespective of whether bills are passed or not for reasons whatsoever. It will be the responsibility of the contractor to submit bills duly filled in all respect within time. The contractor shall be capable for making two month payment to their staff from his own resources, in case bill payment to the contractor from CSPTCL is delayed due to the reason, whatsoever.

If the contractor fails to make payment to deployed staff up to the 10th of every month, then a penalty of Rs. 500/- per day shall be deducted against each such event. In case the same is repeated for 3 times during current contract period then this will affect the performance of the contractor for participation in next tender and the contractor may be debarred/black listed also along with the punitive action.

1.24 **OBSERVANCE OF RULES & REGULATIONS**:

- (a) The work under this contract/agreement shall attract all the laws in force in the State of Chhattisgarh.
- (b) The work will be carried out by observing all the rules and regulations regarding safety from any type of accident which if takes places would be the contractor's responsibility. The contractor shall be responsible for payment of all compensation as applicable from time to time to their workman engaged on the work in the event of any accident.
- (c) The contractor shall obtain necessary license under the Contract Labour Act, 1970, and shall fully comply with requirement of all labour laws including Minimum Wages Act, 1948, Industrial Disputes Act, 1947, Workmen's Compensation Act, 1923, Industrial Employment (Standing Orders) Act, 1946, Employees Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952, and Contract Labour Regulation & Abolition Act. 1970. In case of violation of any Law, Rules & Regulations as mentioned above, being registered in competent Court and in the event of any penalty/fine imposed on CSPTCL due to default of contractor, the CSPTCL reserves the right to recover such amount from contractor's bills/SD or by any other lawful means as it may deem fit and proper. The decision of the CSPTCL shall be final & binding on the contractor.
- (d) The contractor shall be liable to pay his contribution and the employee's contribution to the State Employee Insurance Scheme in respect of all labour employed by him for the execution of the contract, in accordance with the provision of "The Employees State Insurance Act, 1948" as amended from time to time where ever it is applicable in the state otherwise they must have Insurance policy under workman compensation act. In case the contractor fails to submit full details of his account of labour employed and the contribution payable, the Executive Engineer concern shall recover from the running bills of Contractor an amount of contribution as assessed by him. The amount so recovered shall be adjusted against the actual contribution payable for Employees State Insurance.

- (e) However, the employees are to be covered with ESIC/Workman Compensation act as per requirement but apart from this, the contractor shall arrange additional policy for the life/injury of the employee in case of accident, so that proper compensation may be provided to the employee or his kin as the case may be for treatment in hospital/compensation in case of disability/loss of life (to be read with clause 1.29).
- 1.25 **PAYMENT**: The contractor shall be permitted to raise one bill, to be submitted in quadruplicate (four copies) in each calendar month pertaining to each Sub-Station, the contractor shall submit his bill complete in all respect every month. The payment shall be made within 30 days time after last day of the billing cycle **provided other formalities are completed** and also deducting the statutory levies & other deductions, if any. However no interest shall be paid if payment delayed due to unavoidable situation. The contractor has to furnish proof of submission of Provident Fund in respect of the staff employed by him with the monthly bill including certificate of payment (along with details of payment to their employees either through account payee cheque / DD or electronic transfer) made to all of his employees engaged for the works for the bill period. Cash payment to the deployed workers is not admissible. The payment of monthly R.A. Bills will be released only after receipt of documentary evidence towards payment of minimum wages, EPF/ESI subscription etc. certified by Officer-in-charge of the work.
- 1.26 **PAYMENT TO STAFF DEPLOYED BY CONTRACTOR**:- The contractor shall be responsible for payment of wages to each staff up to the 10th of each month. The payment of wages must be in accordance with the provisions of the labour law and as minimum wages declared by Labour commissioner, Govt. of CG. It will be binding on the contractor for monthly payment of Bonus @ 8.33%, Leave wages @ 6%, and to deposit Empoyee & Employer's contribution towards EPF & ESIC on the monthly wages as applicable from time to time.
- 1.27 **DEFECTS IN WORK**:- In case, the Attendant (Helper) engaged for the work is not up to the working level as desired by the concerned officer under whom he/she will be working, the same shall be informed to the contractor & in such cases, the contractor shall engage another suitable Attendant (Helper) in place of him.
- 1.28 **E.P.F. DEDUCTION** :- As per the relevant provisions under Employees Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952, the bidder will have to furnish full particulars of EPF contribution in respect of employee engaged by him. All such details will have to be furnished along with the bill without which the bill will not be accepted. It is mandatory for the contractor/bidder to pay EPF of all the employees engaged for work in the S/S of CSPTCL against this tender in single EPF challan against each Sub Station only, so that CSPTCL can verify the details of number of employees and their PF deduction conveniently. The concern EE (S/S) division will verify the details of each employee EPF Number and amount paid by the contractor to the commissioner EPF office.

1.29 INSURANCE CONCERNING TO STAFF OF CONTRACTOR: -

- (i) The contractor will arrange Health/appropriate insurance policies for arranging compensation to his staff injured on duty of sufficient amount.
- (ii) In case of any accident the total responsibility of whole treatment of employee shall rest on the contractor.
- (iii) CSPTCL will not make any such payment to the contractor's staff or any compensation etc. except the amount of maintenance staff ordered to the contractor.
- (iv) The work contract in substation will be governed by the rules & acts of Factories Act as in existence.

- 1.30 The terms and conditions and specifications mentioned in tender specification shall be binding on the bidders and no condition or stipulation contrary to our condition shall be applicable. Please note that the bidders who do not accept terms and conditions stipulated in this tender specification, their offers are liable to be out rightly rejected without assigning any reason what-so-ever. Each page of TC Bid and Price Bid shall be signed by the bidder & affixed the seal.
- 1.31 <u>Punitive Actions</u> : In case of defaults by the contractor such as non-execution of work, violation/breach of terms and conditions of the contract/submission of fabricated or fraudulent supportive documents etc. and such other, the CSPTCL shall take any one or all the punitive actions given below depending on the extent and seriousness of the default committed :-

a) Debar/blacklist the firm for future business for a specified period.

b) Cancel the contract partially or fully as outlined in Penalty Clause.

c) Impose a suitable penalty on account of financial loss to CSPTCL by the contractor due to default against the contract.

1.32 <u>Arbitration:</u>If, at any time any question, dispute or difference, whatsoever shall arise between the CSPTCL and the bidder, <u>upon</u>, or <u>in relation to</u> or <u>in connection with the Contract</u>, either party may forthwith give to the other, notice in writing of the arise of such question, dispute or difference and the same shall be referred to the adjudication of two arbitrators. In this case one to be nominated by the CSPTCL and the other to be nominated by the bidder or in the case said arbitrators not agreeing, then to the adjudication of the Umpire, to be appointed by the arbitrators, whose decision shall be final and binding on the parties under the provision of the Indian Arbitration Act, 1940 with its latest amendments, and of the rules there-under any statuary modification thereof shall be deemed to apply. The arbitrators or the Umpire, as the case may be, are bound to give a detailed speaking award assigning reasons for the findings.

Service under the contract shall be continued by the Contractor/bidder during the arbitration proceedings, unless otherwise, directed in writing by the CSPTCL or unless the matter is such that the work cannot possibly be continued until the decision of the arbitrators or of the Umpire, as the case may be, is issued.

1.33 <u>Jurisdiction</u>:- All disputes, if any or claim arising out of the contract, agreement, purchase order etc. shall be triable in the competent court at Raipur from where the order is placed and in no other courts.

<u>SECTION – II</u> <u>TERMS AND CONDITIONS</u>

2.1 The contractor will deploy following category personnel with respective minimum qualification, passed from any recognized institution for each substation. The personnel engaged must be domicile of Chhattisgarh state & the contractor has to submit the domicile certificate along with valid ID card issued by Govt. department e.g. Aadhar Card (UID)/ Driving License/Voter ID of the personnel so engaged. The contractor has to submit age proof certificate for Attendant (Helper) and proof of qualification (as mentioned below) at the time of deployment of staff to OIC.

Apart from above, the persons engaged under this contract shall be obedient & well behaved.

- 2.2 Officer-in-charge –The respective Executive Engineer (Sub-station) Dn. will be the Officer in-charge (OIC).
- 2.3 Control room/store room will not be used by contractor's staff for accommodation purpose.
- 2.4 Allotment of residential quarter on minimum requirement basis may be considered by CSPTCL on availability basis and on payment of quarter rental fee and electricity bill.
- 2.5 Necessary material/equipments like torch, gumboot, raincoat, first-aid box with all kits, photo identity card duly signed by In-charge officer etc. will be arranged by contractor at his own cost.
- 2.6 <u>Prices</u>- The rates for the Attendant (Helper) (monthly) shall be in following parts as indicated below:-
 - Base Rate:- The Base rate is the rate of wages determined by the Labour Commissioner, Govt. of C.G. applicable on the date of issue of this tender under relevant provision of Minimum Wages Act-1948 for Unskilled category of worker. This rate is variable (as per wages declared by Labour Commissioner, Govt. of C.G. from time to time).
 - b) **Base charge**: The base charge includes base rate along with all the specific charges/Mandatory payments. e.g. EPF, Insurance, Leave & Bonus.

Specific Charges includes the actual expenses against the payment of EPF/ESI/Bonus. The details of these charges are mentioned below:-

- I. EPF @ of 13% (on minimum wages fixed by the Labour Commissioner Govt. of C.G.as amended from time to time) to be remitted along with the contribution from the labour to the EPF Commissioner regularly and obeying all other legal conditions as per Act. The original Electronic Challan cum receipt shall be submitted for passing the bills.
- II. The ES Insurance @ of 3.25% (on minimum wages fixed by the Labour Commissioner Govt. of C.G.as amended from time to time) to be remitted along with the contribution from the labour to the concern authority and obey all other applicable legal conditions as per Act. The payment of monthly bills submitted by contractor shall be released after production of original documentary evidence towards payment of ESI to concerned department. The contractor shall also submit the original documentary evidence for insurance policy taken under workman compensation act and personal accident. The payment of monthly bills submitted by contractor shall be released after production of original documentary evidence.

If order is placed to the contractor for more than 01 Division then the original receipt of EPF, ESI and other documents will be attested from the Executive Engineer where the original receipt of EPF, ESI & other documents submitted along with bill and photocopy of the EPF, ESI & other documents shall be given to the other division for passing the bills.

- III. Bonus @ 8.33% of base rate to the eligible employee as per the law applicable. The payment against Bonus (@8.33%) will be made on production of original documentary evidence towards payment of Bonus amount to Sub-station Attendant duly authenticated by the Executive Engineer in charge.
- IV. Leave wages @ of 6.00% to the eligible employee as per the law applicable. The payment against Leave wages @ of 6.00% will be made on production of original documentary evidence towards payment of leave wages amount to Helper duly authenticated by the Executive Engineer in charge.

Note 1:- The base rates mentioned above are based on the minimum wages declared (for category-A defined for specified regions) by the labour Department, Govt. Of. C.G., Raipur for the period 01.10.20 to 31.03.21. The base charges calculated above at SI.No.6 is by considering the minimum wages specified for category-A i.e. on higher side and are inclusive of all the Mandatory payments e.g. EPF, Insurance, Leave wages and Bonus, etc. However, the base charges shall be escalated at the time of revision of EPF, ESI rate & minimum wages declared by the Labour Department, Govt. of C.G variation.

<u>Note 3</u>:- In case, the lowest rate is quoted by more than one firm, then successful bidder among the lowest bidders shall be decided on the basis of lottery. Lottery will be drawn in presence of representatives of the firms. After drawl of lottery no any claim shall be entertained from any of the bidder. A form of under taking annexed with the tender is to be signed by the bidder necessarily in this respect

2.7 **Price Bid**: Price bid has to be submitted in prescribed format only as per Schedule-III. The base charges that to be paid by contractor will be variable depending upon rate declared by Labour Department from time to time. However the Rate quoted over & above base charges in price bid shall be FIRM throughout contract period which will include administrative & supervision charges and Profit. The rates quoted in Percentage will not be considered. Bidder should quote lowest rate without taxes and duties. This quoted rate (over and above base charges) will remain fixed for the entire contract period & extension period given, if any.

GST/Cess, if any shall be paid extra by CSPTCL at actual. The offer with the rates given in any form/Proforma, other than that mentioned in Schedule-III shall be liable for rejection.

The rate (over and above base charges) shall be quoted in FIRM Rupees (rate in words should also be mentioned along with figures). Lowest bidder (L-1) shall be evaluated on the basis of total value of contract. All amounts should be rounded-off to two decimal places.

Price bid must be without any assumption, condition, qualification, reservation or variation. Conditional tender offer or offers at variance from prescribed specification shall be turned ineligible.

2.8 <u>LIQUIDATED DAMAGES</u>:- In case, the Attendant(Helper) deployed by the Contractor involves in illegal activities such as theft of materials/properties of the office/Sub-station, misappropriation or any other similar activities which cause liquidated damages to the Sub-station/Office, then responsibility of the same shall lie on the Contractor & shall have to be managed/recovered from the Contactor.

2.9 **TERMINATION OF CONTRACT:**-

The work order / contract can be terminated at any time by either side on giving 15 days notice in advance without assigning any reason whatsoever. In such cases, either party will not be responsible for any loss or compensation to be paid to the other party.

2.10 CONTRACTOR'S LIABILITY FOR LOSS, DAMAGE, ACCIDENT, ETC.:

- a) The contractor shall indemnify and save the CSPTCL against all actions, suits, claims, demands, costs or expenses arising in connection with injury suffered prior to the date when the work shall have been taken over by person employed by the contractor, his subcontractor on the works whether under the General law or under the Workman's Compensation Act. 1923 or any other statutes or law in force dealing with the question of the liability of the employers and shall so take steps properly to ensure against any claims there under.
- b) On the occurrence of an accident which results in the death of any of the workman employed by the contractor or which is so serious as to be likely to result in death of any such workman, the contractor shall intimate immediately telephonically and in writing within 24 hours of happening of such accident to the concerned Executive Engineer of the CSPTCL related to all concerned the fact of such accident. The contractor shall indemnify the CSPTCL, against all loss or damage sustained resulting due to directly or indirectly from contractor's failure, including all liabilities, if any, under the Workman's Compensation Act., or otherwise to conform to the provision of the said Act, in regard to such accident/incident.
- c) In the event of any claim, being made, any action brought against the CSPTCL, any dispute arising out of the matter referred to or in respect of which to contract is liable under this clause; the contractor shall immediately notify thereof. And he shall, with the assistance, if he so requires from the CSPTCL but at the sole expense of all liabilities the contractor will conduct all negotiations for the settlement of the same or any litigation that may arise, there from. In such case, the CSPTCL shall at the expense of the contractor, will provide assistance for any such purposes.
- d) In the event of an accident, compensation if any may become payable under Workman's Compensation Act 1923 should be responsibility of the contractor.
- e) The amount of all costs, damages or expenses or other sums which under this clause or any other terms & conditions of contract shall be payable by the contractor to the CSPTCL or same may be deducted by the CSPTCL from any money due/becoming due to the contractor under the same or any other contract

terms & conditions. Without any prejudice CSPTCL right to recover the same by ordinary process of law.

f) The contractor has to protect the theft of equipment and other materials of EHV substations. In case of theft the FIR shall be lodged by the contractor's personnel. In case of loss to CSPTCL due to theft, the same shall be made available or to be provided by the contractor.

2.11 WORKERS ENGAGED BY THE CONTRACTOR:

- i. The CSPTCL will not be in any manner, responsible for any act, omission or commission of the workers engaged by Contractor and no claim in this respect will lie on the CSPTCL. If any such claim is made against the CSPTCL by any worker engaged/employed by the Contractor, which the CSPTCL is obliged to discharge by virtue of any statute of any provision of law and rules due to mere fact of the workers of the Contractor working at the Sub-station premises or otherwise, the Contractor will be liable to indemnity/reimburse the CSPTCL all the money paid in addition to the expenses incurred.
- ii. The Contractor shall be responsible in respect of the employment or nonemployment of the working force engaged by him at his own level and the CSPTCL shall have no role to play in the said matter. In case any loss is caused to the CSPTCL by the working force of the contractor, by the deeds or litigation, then the Contractor shall have to bear the cost of such litigation along with the value of the loss caused.
- iii. The Contractor shall engage the work force as per the required qualifications & it shall be the responsibility of the Contractor to maintain the records of the employees deployed by him as required in terms of the various labour laws.
- iv. The contractor shall obtain necessary license under the Contract Labour Act, 1970, and shall fully comply with requirement of all labour laws including Minimum Wages Act, 1948, Industrial Disputes Act, 1947, Workmen's Compensation Act, 1923, Industrial Employment (Standing Orders) Act, 1946, Employees Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952, ES Insurance Act 1948, and any other labour law as applicable in the State of Chhattisgarh. Contractor will keep all workers fully insured as per law and which will remain valid and operative till the expiry of work order or time if extended further. In case if violation of any Rules, Regulations, Laws Acts etc. as mentioned above, registered in competent Court and any type of penalty/fine imposed on CSPTCL due to default of contractor, the CSPTCL reserves the right to recover such amount from contractor's bills/SD or by any other means. The decision of the CSPTCL shall be final & binding on the contractor.
- 2.12 For any unforeseen happenings, accident etc., the risk will be covered by the contractor and Company will no way liable for any type of compensation.
- 2.13 Any other instructions/condition issued from time to time by the Company's competent authority will be observed by the contractor.
- 2.14 The contractor will issue the Identity Card with photograph to his staff and it will be obligatory to exhibit the I-Card while on duty. The contractor will not change his staff without proper justification & bringing in knowledge of OIC of the work. The list of all staff with full address along with proof of qualification & two copy of photograph will be handed over by contractor to OIC for official record. The contractor must submit police verification report of their staff before deployment to OIC.
- 2.15 The payment to the employees deployed has to be ensured by contractor, through account payee Cheque/DD/Electronic transfer or by credit to employees bank account. Cash payment is not admissible.
- 2.16 All the Staff will be employed by the contractor and there shall be no master and servant relationship between the workers and the CSPTCL.

- 2.17 If the performance of the contractor is not found satisfactory or not found performing as per the operating instructions by Sub-Station In charge, at any time, the contract may be terminated by the CSPTCL. The decision of the Company shall be final and binding.
- 2.18 The employee deployed by the contractor should be conversant for utilization of fire extinguisher and safety appliances in emergency.
- 2.19 Uniform should be provided by the contractors to their staff.
